# ***DOD Customs EUCOM EDDOC ICTB***

## **Objectives**

- Educate group on custom stamp procedures and Customs Form 302 usage
- Discuss recent customs problems and solutions
- Discuss E-customs initiative and provide realistic update
- Discuss changes in governing regulations

## **Accomplishments**

- All objectives were met
- ICTB coordinated with all components on an acceptable notification system for conducting SAVs. ICTB also published an SAV schedule. During 2009, SAVs were performed at 17 locations in 8 countries

# ***EID CONOPS EUCOM DDOC, Sust. & Dist.***

## **Objectives**

- Define business rules for TWCF funded surface routes
- Discuss back haul inefficiencies
- Discuss centralized control of all theater surface movements

## **Accomplishments**

- Centralized C2 of surface movements-EUCOM action in coord w/TRANSCOM and DLA. Assembled EUCOM working group (Components / National Partners)
- Monthly Theater Distribution Meetings. Monthly AO-level IDL meetings were expanded to include topics like backhaul and C2
- Line by line review of CONOPS to approve changes. Approved Quarterly Theater Distribution VTC in January with EDDOC Chief, DLA-E, TCJ5/4-S
- CONOPS to EUCOM Directive began June 2009



# *Foreign Military Sales EUCOM EDDOC*

## **Objectives**

- Present CONOPS update to WG members
- Review DRAFT message for ECJ4 DIR release
- Review DRAFT FMS instructions for movement through Ramstein AB

## **Accomplishments**

- The Albanian FMS shipment ran into issues because they were not a Form 302 holding nation. The subject shipment was sent via Defense Courier Service
- DSCA has determined that the U.S. can retain title over FMS cargo only on exception and must be approved in advance by the DSCA Strategy Directorate
- The CONOPS has been published and is up to Version 15

# ***USC-05 Shipper Carrier WG 598<sup>th</sup> Transportation Group (SDDC)***

## ***Objectives***

- Opportunity for Face-to-Face discussion
- Communicate Expectations
- Address Shipper / Carrier Concerns
- Improve Performance through Mutual Understanding

## ***Accomplishments***

- Coordinated with SDDC OPS and TRANSCOM on a variety of discrepancies, and have successfully changed the contract language to better support commercial shipments in EUCOM and AFRICOM
- Have lobbied at all levels of SDDC to improve IBS functionality, to include preparing a white-paper for TRANSCOM Science & Technology Funding for system upgrades
- For first time, all SDDC Quality Assurance Offices are using standardized systems/process to monitor carrier performance. TRANSCOM/SDDC OPS adopted 598<sup>th</sup>'s plan as a potential template for SDDC-wide application

# ***LIS Working Group EDDOC***

## ***Objectives***

- FACTS and ACA Working Group—Provides a forum to discuss, analyze, and mitigate unauthorized cargo airlift
- RFID / AIT Working Group—Complying with EUCOM Instruction appointing USAREUR as Lead Service Agent for theater Automatic Identification Technology, USAREUR chairs this working group with Component and Supporting Agencies attending

## ***Accomplishments***

- Since theater-wide FACTS implementation in Jun 07, unauthorized cargo airlift costs have reduced from \$10 million per month to roughly \$2 million
- Identified a need for LNs to have FACTS access. Procedure was developed and works
- Requirements for inter-service component MOAs were identified and subsequently developed during the past year
